As state and local budgets for special education services shrink, parents have to advocate harder in order to simply preserve the supports that are important to their child with a disability.

In this 2 hour program, disability law experts from Hinkle, Fingles and Prior will discuss the changes that have resulted from budget cuts, and describe what parents and educators/advocates need to know in order to preserve services for students who need them.

They will share concrete strategies to help parents work as effective members of the IEP team. They will describe how to effectively monitor the IEP to ensure that the student is making progress. And, they will discuss a full range of conflict resolution strategies to help reach agreement, and secure services without going to court. They will share the important timeline information parents need to know to preserve services.
